#### **49TH CADET TRAINING SQUADRON COMMANDER**

## **Tom Doyle**

The 49th Cadet Training Squadron of the Cadet Training Group is unique in Cadet Training Group history. No cadets were ever assigned to the 49th CTS; the number was set aside to honor a former member of the Cadet Training Group. Cadet Captain Tom Doyle was a Northern California youth who was a leader in his school and community, a licensed pilot at age 17 and an outstanding member of the Civil Air Patrol. Cadet Doyle was selected to command the 18th CTS at Fort Ord in the summer of 1980.

However, a change in personnel requirements resulted in the activation of only one CTS instead of the three that were planned. Shortly after the Fort Ord Encampment, Cadet Doyle commanded Delta Flight, 17th CTS at McClellan AFB. At 17 he earned his FAA private pilot certificate and won an appointment to the U.S. Air Force Academy, where he graduated in the top 5% of his class.

After completing training as a F-16 fighter pilot, he was stationed in Germany (NATO) at Hahn Air Base with the 10 TFS "Fighting Tenth" (USAFE). On one grim cloudy day in the spring of 1988, 1st Lieutenant Tom E. "Popeye" Doyle's F-16 experienced catastrophic engine failure while flying over the center of the city of Forst. Although he could have bailed out, Lt. Doyle elected to stay with his crippled fighter to guide it away from the shops, schools and congestion below. He succeeded, but was killed when his F-16 impacted the ground. His heroic actions helped save countless lives that day.

In 1989, the Cadet Training Group recognized Lt. Doyle by naming posthumously, as the commander of the 49th Cadet Training Squadron. The guidon of the 49th Cadet Training Squadron appears on the Cadet Training Group shield as a reminder of our CTG hero.

After being cleared to attend the activity, the students met with the CTG Commander, C/Lt Col Lydia R Philp, to go over what the Encampment Contract entailed. The Encampment Contract displayed the guidelines and expectations that were to be held throughout the week for the students. As soon as the commitment was made, their journey through Encampment began. The students would now endure a week of rigorous training to better themselves in their cadet careers. They used teamwork to build each other up, discipline to further their respect to superiors and others, and excellence in completing Encampment to the best of their abilities.















































Cadets attend encampment to learn and build as both an individual and a team. In processing and the beginning in the journey is now past as the students continue their commitment to the program.

Saturday began with an intense environment. The students participated in physical training with their flight in the early morning and then marched to the Commander's Welcome. Lieutenant Colonel Edinboro spoke to the students about how challenging this activity will be to each of them. The students then learned about the Wingman concept, using the buddy teams who look out for one another and help each other through the week. The Warrior Spirit gives cadets a fortitude and resiliency to succeed in the difficult challenges encampment offers them. Students learned about the history of CAP, the proper wear of CAP uniforms and the importance of attitude and discipline. The flight staff began teaching the cadets drill & ceremonies, and the students had their first barracks inspection. Students are learning how to function in the encampment environment, and gaining an understanding of what they will need to accomplish to graduate at the end of the week.

These students are just starting their training and are in the beginning phases of encampment. They have much to learn, and will grow as members of their flight, squadron, and finally the Cadet Training Group by the end of the week.




































#### **SUNDAY: DAY TWO**

Sunday provides a pivotal moment as the students at encampment continue to work with their flight staff and fellow students, as well as experience their first inspection. After constructive direction, the students begin coming together as a team while they train.

The students participated in their daily physical training and attended either religious services (Protestant or Catholic) or a character development class. After services (or character development), students learned about how cadets can transition to military careers. During a subsequent class on Customs and Courtesies, students learned military traditions related to respecting others. Students received a briefing on how to conduct a preflight inspection to prepare the students for their upcoming orientation flights. Flight staff took advantage of time between classes to practice volleyball for the upcoming competition later in the week. The flight staff continued to train their students on drill and ceremonies as well as barracks skills, concluding with an inspection to check on progress.

For each cadet to succeed at encampment, they must learn to rely on their teammates and their flight to accomplish more than they can accomplish on their own.












#### **MONDAY: DAY THREE**

There was a lot of excitement in Monday's schedule! Early in the morning, cadets were awakened by their flight cadre to begin PT. Today the Cadet Training Group participated in Orientation Rides at the San Luis Obispo County Regional Airport. This activity enables cadets to learn more about the Aerospace Education mission of CAP. Cadets received a 60-minute Orientation Flight in a Civil Air Patrol Cessna 182! Flights also went through the Obstacle Course, which is highly physically demanding. Today's obstacles helped cadets realize that by coming together as a team, each could succeed.

Ending this eventful day, cadets were inspected by the Squadron Commander and First Sergeant for the first time, and teamwork and discipline were heavily emphasized. The cadets are learning and improving each day. As they come together as a team, they continue to improve.





#### **TUESDAY: DAY 4**

Four days into the 2016 CAWG Encampment and the action continues to be exciting! Cadets continued orientation flights in the Cessna 182; we completed 195 orientation flights!. Many cadets had their first flight ever! Students enjoyed marksmanship training at the United States Army Engagement Skills Trainer 2000, where students fired simulation M4/M16 rifles at targets on a computerized simulation range.

Multiple flights also attended class highlighting the plethora of activities offered in CAP, from Search & Rescue to National Cadet Special Activities. Students also attended a hands-on class focused on Aerospace.

















































## **WEDNESDAY: DAY 5**

Wednesday was a busy day for your cadets! They began with their first Group level PT (physical training), lead by their Group Superintendent, C/Capt Brown. At 0900, the California Army National Guard began flying cadets in the CH-47 Chinook! Not a single cadet left that helicopter without a giant smile on their face. Later in the day, the entire CTG practiced for the much anticipated Graduation Ceremony on Friday morning.

Ending the day was the final Squadron Inspection, where teamwork and accountability were heavily emphasized. The Flight and Squadron Inspections are in preparation for the Group Inspection, one of the culminating activities of Encampment on Thursday evening. At the end of Inspections, the Squadron debriefs focused on improving skills and teamwork to accomplish the mission.

























































#### **THURSDAY: DAY 6**

The cadets are one step closer to graduating! Flight participated in the second Group Level PT, and final PT of the week. Immediately following PT, flights went to eat breakfast and get ready for the Group Drill Competition. This Drill Competition tests cadets and Flight Cadre on the most complex drill movements they have learned during the week.

After Drill Competition, cadets went to the Group Volleyball Competition, testing their teamwork, communication, and volleyball skills. Next came the Group Run; the whole Group comes together and runs, as a team, signifying their entry into the Cadet Training Group.

During the afternoon, cadets prepared for the Group Inspection. This white glove inspection, done by the Cadet Commander, is intense. After the inspection, cadets take their final exam to as an indicator of what they have learned over the week, which is compared to their entrance exam. After the inspection and exam, the cadets relaxed, and even had an opportunity to eat pizza, drink soda, and dance!

After the march back to their barracks, the night ended with cadets in bed, possibly thinking about how Encampment has changed them, how they have been influenced this week, and how excited they are to go home and sleep in their own beds.
