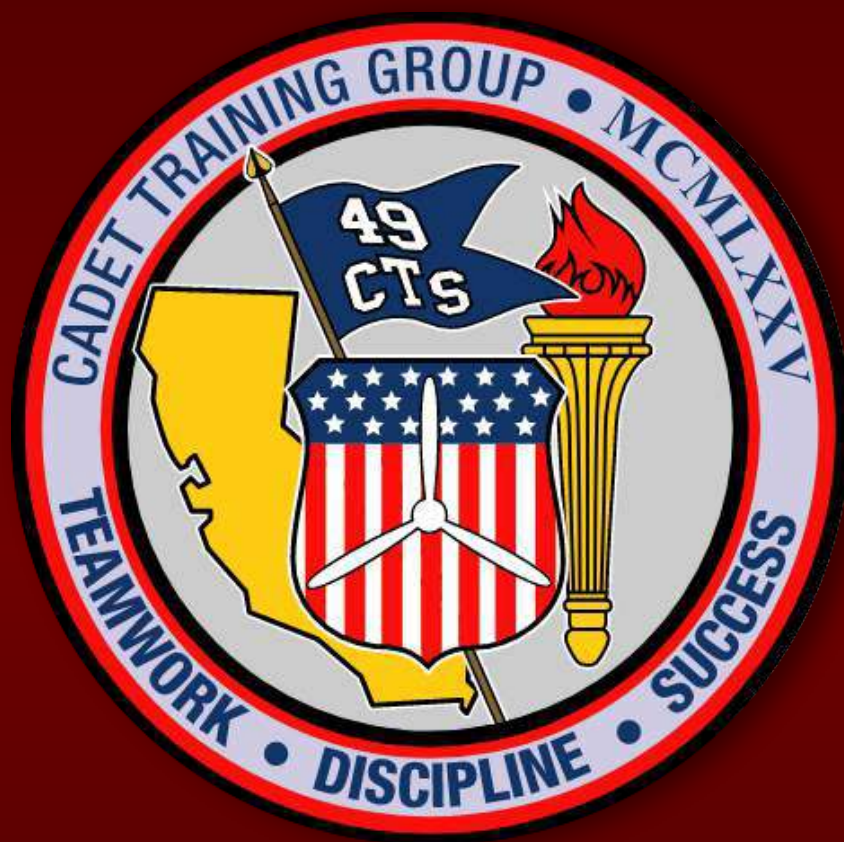

49th Cadet Training Squadron

Cadet Captain Tom Doyle 49th CTS Commander

The 49th Cadet Training Squadron of the Cadet Training Group is unlike any other in CTG history. No cadets were ever assigned to the 49th CTS, as the number was set aside in honor of a former member of the Cadet Training Group. Cadet Captain Tom Doyle was a Northern California youth who was a leader in both his school and community, a licensed pilot at age 17 and an outstanding cadet member of the Civil Air Patrol. Cadet Doyle was selected to command the 18th CTS at Ford Ord in the summer of 1980. However, a change in personnel requirements resulted in the activation of only one CTS in 1980 instead of the three initially planned squadrons. Shortly after the Fort Ord Encampment, Cadet Doyle commanded Delta Flight, 17th CTS at McClellan AFB.

At 17, Doyle earned his FAA private pilot's certificate and shortly thereafter won an appointment to the prestigious U.S. Air Force Academy, where he graduated in the top 5% of his class. After completing training as an F-16 fighter pilot, he was stationed in Germany (NATO) with the 10 TFS "Fighting Tenth" (USAFE).

On one grim cloudy day in the spring of 1988, 1st Lieutenant Tom E. "Popeye" Doyle's F-16 fighter jet experienced sudden catastrophic engine failure while over the center of the city of Forst. Although he could have bailed out, 1st Lt Doyle elected to stay with his crippled fighter to guide it away from the shops, schools and congestion below. He succeeded in his heroic act, but perished in the ensuing crash.

In 1989, the Cadet Training Group recognized 1st Lt and former Cadet Captain Doyle by naming him posthumously, as the commander of the 49th Cadet Training Squadron. The guidon of the 49th Cadet Training Squadron appears on the Cadet Training Group shield as a reminder of our CTG hero.



In Memoriam: Capt Kenneth W. "K3" Sturgill



On July 7, 2016, The California Wing lost one of its most dynamic young members, Capt Kenneth W. Sturgill (A1C, USAF) passed away on the final day of the Air Force Survival, Evasion, Resistance and Escape (SERE) Instructor Selection Course at Joint Base San Antonio-Camp Bullis in Texas. Kenneth, known affectionately as "K3", had recently received top honors as an honor graduate and tied for top graduate of a class of 715 trainees from Air Force basic training at Lackland Air Force Base before beginning SERE training.

Kenneth joined Civil Air Patrol as a cadet in 2007 at the age of 12. During his time as a cadet, Kenneth attended numerous wing and national activities, including eight encampments. Eventually reaching the grade of C/Lt Col, Kenneth was the 2013 Cadet of the Year for the California Air Force Association, and was a qualified Mission Observer, Ground Team Leader, and was recognized with the Lifesaving Award that he received along with his father for a ground team mission they participated in together. Before reaching the required age of 21 years, K3 became a Senior Member so that he could serve as a training officer at the wing encampment and assist as an escort for the International Air Cadet Exchange program.

K3's dream was to join the Air Force and serve his country. With an eye towards becoming a PJ (Pararescueman) in the United States Air Force, K3 began training and becoming physically prepared for the rigorous testing. After being accepted into the training program, K3 was injured and was forced to postpone his enlistment. Never to be discouraged, K3 embraced his rehabilitation and was soon reporting to Lackland Air Force Base for Basic Military Training, this time with a slot in the Survival, Evasion, Resistance and Escape (SERE) Instructor Selection Course. Following his graduation from BMT, K3 attended SERE training, where he selflessly gave of his time to help and encourage his fellow airmen trainees and CAP members back home. On his last day of SERE training, K3 was found in the field unresponsive and could not be resuscitated.

To know Kenneth was to love him and everything he embodied. His life goals were based on the USAF Pararescue motto – "These Things We Do, That Others May Live." He exemplified the core value of "Service Before Self" in everything that he did and could be counted on to lend a hand whenever needed. Kenneth left this world doing what he loved most and living his dream, in the service of his nation. He was a leader beyond his years. Kenneth was our brother, our fellow airman, our commander, our teacher, our mentor, our son, and most of all, our friend. Although he may no longer be with us physically, the gifts that he gave us all will live forever in our wing and everyone he touched.
